



## Term and Code Index

### 1. Rotational & Phase Codes

- **R1 – R6:** Refers to the six standard volleyball **Rotations**  
e.g., R1 is Rotation 1 / Setter in 1
- **Serve Phase:** The tactical layout when your team is serving.
- **Reception Phase:** The tactical layout when your team is receiving the opponent's serve.

### 2. Player & Position Abbreviations

The app uses shorthand to represent specific roles or players on the court:

- Opp / Dgn: The Opponent's Opposite/Diagonal hitter.
- Sett / Str: The Setter
- Mb1 / Mb2: Middle Blocker 1 and 2
- OH1 / OH2: Outside Hitters (Hitters 1 and 2)
- Lbr: The Libero

### 3. Match-up Logic

Statements in the "Match-up Analysis" section ("X vs Y code") describe how many rotations a specific player is matched against an opponent in a certain phase:

Example: "**Mark 2 vs Opp front**" means: Mark blocks for 2 rotations against the opponent Opposite when that player is in the front row.
